What once started out as a vision in Frank Barber's eyes earned on throughout the years after his death in 1973 through the collaboration of his nephew, Tony Barber & Lucky Strike Lanes. Tony passed away on January 27, 2024, just a month before the start of the 94th event. This year, Lucky Strike Lanes found it a fitting tribute to rename the historical tournament in honor of not only Frank, but Tony as well by re-naming the prestigious event to the "Barber Memorial" Eastern Duckpin Classic. The tournament is and will presumably always be known for its longevity, being the oldest consecutively run tournament in the history of duckpins - now in its 95th year!

During the late 1920's into the early 1930's Frank Barber & the then secretary of the NDBC, George Iseman arranged bowling matches that involved top bowlers from Connecticut & the Baltimore area - singles, doubles, teams were formed and the competitors were witnessed by large crowds of people. Frank was also known for his famed traveling Connecticut Blue Ribbons Team consisting of the original duckpinner's Jack White, Bill Taro, Carl Frisk, Joe Gackel and Nick Trovsky.

The popularity & new image of the duckpin game brought on the birth of the Eastern Sweepstakes in 1931. Frank's vision & preservation brought bowlers from the south to the north to compete in a 15-game singles competition for guaranteed prizes. As time went on, the desire to have bowlers partake in the opportunity to join in regardless of their average brought on more interest & the highest participation in 1969 of 388 bowlers.

Throughout the years Tony Barber became a partner with Lucky Strike Lanes, maintaining the elite status of the tournament and collected news articles & clippings of the Eastern events & became known as the historian of the event. His compilation of these articles is displayed each year in several books which steadily narrate the history of the past ninety-five years of hosting.

The Dumack Family and the staff at Lucky Strike continue to strive and make this tournament a major duckpin bowling attraction. They welcome you this year to the 95th anniversary - enjoy the bowling and camaraderie of your fellow bowlers, and those you meet along the way...
