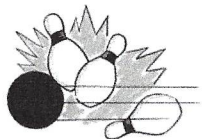

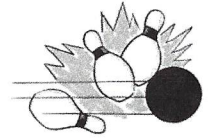

THERE WILL BE THREE (3) OPTIONAL POOLS RUN DURING THIS EVENT:

SCRATCH POOL — \$5.00 Per Entry

Five (5) games total pinfall without handicap to determine winners. All monies collected for this pool will be paid out: 1st: 50%, 2nd: 25%, 3rd: 15%, 4th: 10%.

HIGH SINGLE POOL — \$2.00 Per Entry

Scratch and handicapped high single games will be paid. A bowler can win only one (1) prize per entry. All monies collected for this pool will be paid out. The number of winners and the amount of each prize is based on the number of entries.

DOUBLES POOL — \$6.00 Per Team

Both members of a team must bowl on the same shift. Each bowler takes his or her best three games of the tournament. Handicap will be 80% based on a 300 average limit. A bowler can enter only once each time they bowl in the tournament. All monies collected for this pool will be paid out: 1st: 50%, 2nd: 30%, 3rd: 20%.

OFFICIAL TOURNAMENT RULES AND ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

- I. A. Bowlers must be current members of the National Duckpin Bowling Congress and have proof of average.
- B. Dudek Tournament entrance average will be:
 1. 2023-2024 Composite Average of all sanctioned games bowled in RI or MA adult leagues and tournaments (21 games or more).
 2. Out of state bowlers who are not covered by the above rule will use their 2023-2024 Composite Average of all sanctioned games bowled in their home area plus all sanctioned games bowled in RI and MA (21 games or more). Composite Average = Total Pinfall / Total Games.
 3. If above does not apply, then 2022-2023 Composite Average of all sanctioned games bowled in RI or MA adult leagues and tournaments will be used (21 games or more).
 4. Out of state bowlers who are not covered by the above rules will use their 2022-2023 Composite Average of all sanctioned games bowled in their home area plus all sanctioned games bowled RI and MA (21 games or more). Composite Average = Total Pinfall / Total Games.
 5. If above does not apply, then 2024-2025 highest sanctioned adult winter league average will be used (21 games or more). Proof of average is mandatory.
 6. If above does not apply, then 2024 highest sanctioned adult summer league or tournaleague average will be used (21 games or more). Proof of average is mandatory.
 7. If above does not apply, once a bowler rolls 21 games or more during the 2024-2025 Dudek Tournament season, that bowler will use their current tournament average.
 8. For bowlers using an NDYA average will use their 2023-2024 composite average of all NDYA games (21 games or more).
 9. If above does not apply, then the bowler bowls scratch (160 average).
- C. Non-sanctioned bowlers may bowl upon payment of membership fee.
- II. Bowlers who roll 21 games or more during the 2024-2025 Dudek Tournament Season and average more than their 2024-2025 entrance average determined by Rule I. B. will have their average re-rated upwards by 1/2 the difference, with all fractions rounded down.
- III. Presenting a true average is the responsibility of the bowler.
- IV. Bowler must pay entry fee in advance of beginning any event.
- V. Bowlers may re-enter multiple times in each event and cash as many times as they enter, but can cash only once in the guaranteed prize list.
- VI. A bowler qualifies for the Dudek Tournament End-of Season Playoffs by finishing in the regular prize list in any Dudek Tournament event. A bowler can qualify for the End-of Season Playoffs once during the season. If a bowler cashes more than once during the season, then qualifying spots will be given to bowlers who have yet to qualify for the End-of Season Playoffs based on order of finish in each event. If there is a tie for the last qualifying spot in an event, then all bowlers tied for that spot will be allowed to bowl in the Dudek Tournament End-of Season Playoffs.
- VII. A bowler must bowl at least 21 Dudek Tournament games in order to retain their spot in the End-of Season Playoffs. If a bowler fails to satisfy this requirement, then that bowler will lose his or her spot in the playoffs. Any spot forfeited because of this rule will not be replaced.
- VIII. All previous RIDBPA Tournament Series Finals Champions will receive an automatic spot in the 2025 Dudek Tournament end-of-season playoffs provided they satisfy the requirement outlined in Rule VII.
- IX. Handicap for all single-division events will be 80% based on 160 average limit.
- X. Total pinfall plus handicap determines order of finish. In each Dudek Tournament event, all games rolled in that event must be counted when determining order of finish.
- XI. Questions not covered by the above rules will be governed by NDBC.
